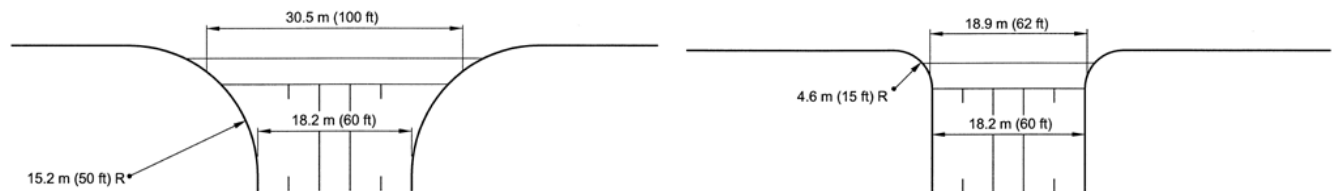


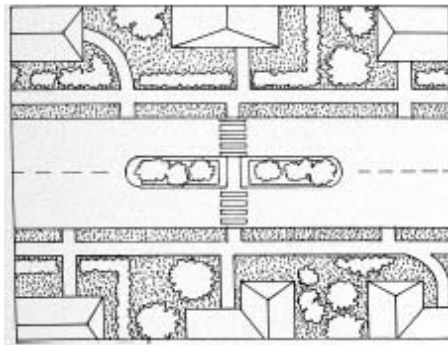

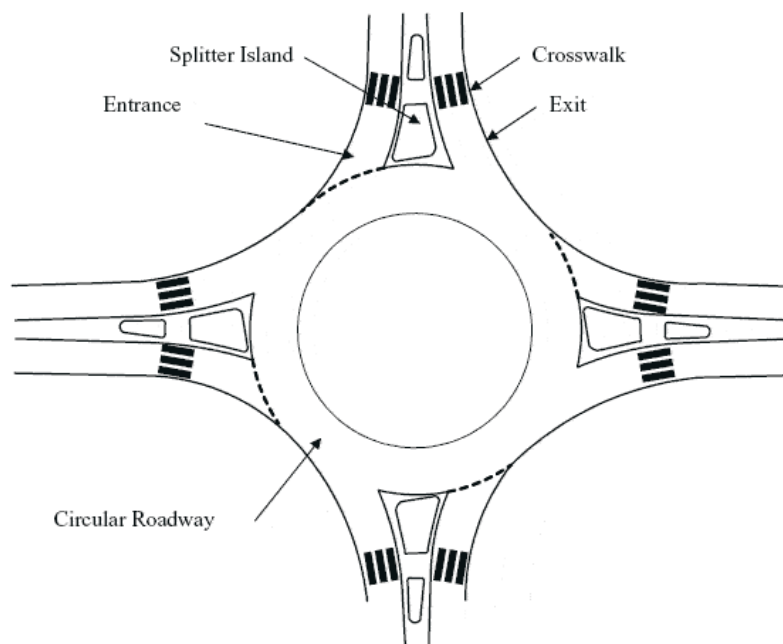
Curb Radius Reduction:



Landscaped Medians & Pedestrian Refuge Islands:

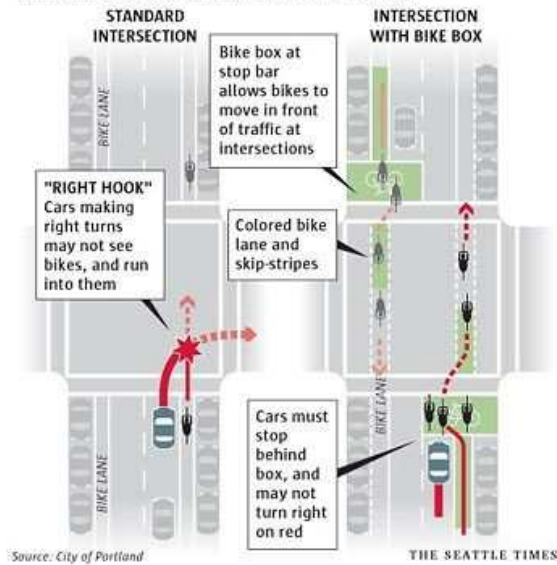


Roundabout:

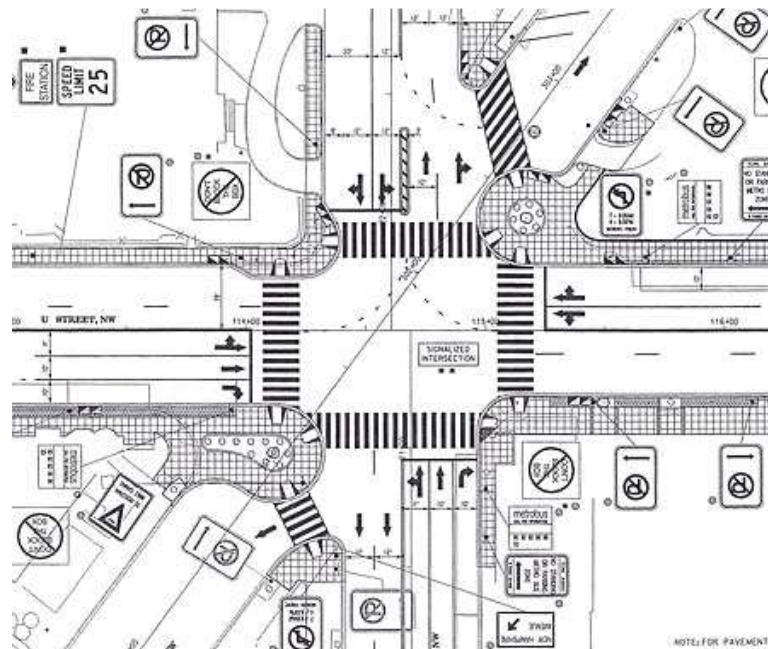


Bike Lanes and Bike Boxes:

Beware the "right hook" crash
Riders in a bicycle lane can get hit when a motorist turns right at an intersection, as depicted here. Portland is trying "bike boxes" and painted bicycle lanes to make cyclists more visible.



Bulb Outs:



Also consider:

- Combinations of the above and other traffic calming devices
- Speed reduction
- Shorten pedestrian crossing distances
- High visibility crosswalks and well designed curb ramps
- Signal timing to allow ample crossing time for most vulnerable pedestrians
- Use of landscaping throughout
- Land use improvements to bring buildings closer to the street & increase activity
- Narrowing and even eliminating travel lanes
