Check your bike!

safe to ride

brakes work

right size

air pressure

quick releases tight

No?? → **HUB!**

HUB is our on-campus bicycle workshop where you can learn how to fix your bike and find all the tools you need.

You are traffic! =

ride with traffic!

Never ride against traffic!

Avoid the most common SPLAT!

follow ALL traffic laws

Stop at red lights and stop signs, signal, be predictable, and respect drivers. Bike law requires white front light and red rear reflector at night.

no sidewalk riding

- 1) Another common SPLAT
- 2) Not cool to endanger pedestrians
- 3) It's against the law in Prescott!

Control your ride!

scan all movements

Scan before you enter traffic—look for cars, pedestrians, bikes, dogs, whatever's moving; join the flow and keep scanning.

take the lane!

When there's no room to share, ride in the center of the lane. We've even got a law to back you up: A.R.S. 28-815

use your ears

Leave the headphones, dance to the sounds of traffic instead.
